About Jimmy's Cambridge

Founded in 1995, Jimmy's is a pioneering, community-focused organisation tackling homelessness within Cambridge.

More than **1,000 people** in Cambridge currently face some sort of housing crisis

The most recent figures show homelessness increasing in Cambridge by **20%**

By valuing and respecting everyone who needs our services, we work with each person to provide options, tools, and skills to support them to move from the street to a home.

Our approach focuses on two areas:

Providing support: delivering an inclusive, supportive environment to help people manage a range of challenging needs. This includes specialist guidance for mental health difficulties, support for people with addiction, and bespoke help such as life-skills workshops, leisure activities, and advice and guidance.

Providing a home: we offer choices for more independent living, ranging from emergency accommodation at our East Road home, to shared housing across Cambridge, to innovative modular homes: movable, small-scale homes that provide residents with their own front door.



Fundraise for Jimmy's Cambridge

When you support Jimmy's, you are helping us to provide accommodation, deliver vital support to those in need, and ensure we can move people out of homelessness and into their own home.

Fundraising for Jimmy's is also a fun way to bring your community together for a shared purpose and fundraising can help you develop skills and meet new people.

There are limitless ways in which you can fundraise for us, and we love to see how creative our supporters are. To get you started, we've put together some popular ideas:

Inform: hold a service or event about homelessness along with a collection for Jimmy's Cambridge

Entertain: host a bake sale, auction of promises, arts and crafts workshop or performance evening. Sell tickets, refreshments, and hold a raffle at the event

Celebrate: put on a special event around a key event in your community's calendar, such as a Christmas carol concert, a feast for Eid, or a BBQ alongside a school Sports Day or Bonfire Night

Challenge: there may be members of your community that want to enter a challenge event, like the Cambridge Half-Marathon, a sponsored swim or walk, a charity football match or cycling – or even skateboarding – between two key locations. Other members of the community can then support this by sponsoring their activities.



Case study: jogging for Jimmy's

In May 2020, a group of 14 friends from across Cambridge came together to raise money for Jimmy's in lockdown by running as far as they could in a month. Supporters were encouraged to sponsor the runners, or pay a small 'entry fee' to run themselves and contribute to the total distance covered.

This challenge event raised more than

£3,000

and the team covered more than

1,000 km

during the challenge.



Harry's story

In 2017, Harry unexpectedly found himself on the streets of Cambridge. He spent that entire summer on the streets, feeling derelict, denounced and decrepit. He felt invisible sometimes 'wanting to just sleep and not wake up again.' This was until he found his way to Jimmy's.

Harry moved into East Road and with support from Jimmy's, was helped into supported housing, before he moved to his own flat. Thanks to our work, Harry has rebuilt his life and now lives independently as a part of the Cambridge community.

“Without Jimmy's I do not know where I would be now. They took me from street to shelter to house to home. Today will be a better day and the future is open again.”

In 2021, we supported more than **400 people** through Jimmy's network of homes

75% of people progress from emergency accommodation to more independent living within a year
